In response to Helping Hugs' annual education appeal, our donors have reached a milestone: \$17,250 raised for the three schools of our sister parish in Haiti! A great big Helping Hugs "hug" to all who participated!

- a nutritious school lunch program;
- tuition for 30 secondary school students attending the Catholic school in Côtes-de-Fer.

#### Teacher Training in Côtes-de-Fer

Thanks to the funds provided by St. William to St. Joseph every month, Father Islaire was able to arrange training for twenty-one teachers and three school directors in September.

Ms. Sonia Thélusmond, a teacher in the diocese, provided instruction in the French language, classroom management, and course preparation.

Although the language of the people is Haitian Creole, French is the medium of instruction in most schools because it is the principal written and administratively authorized language. Imagine having to learn a new language as you progress through your education!

School personnel stayed at the rectory, studied throughout the day and did homework in the evenings for a week. Four follow-up sessions are planned for the remainder of the year.
